Talk on "Impact of Oil & Gas Energy in Digital and Electrical Transformation"

02.12.2021



The Tamilnadu State Centre of the Institution of Engineers (India) organised the lecture meeting on the topic "Impact of Oil & Gas Energy in Digital and Electrical Transformation" on 2nd December 2021 at 6.00 pm through online Zoom Meeting.

At the outset., **Er S Kannan**, **FIE** Chairman, IE(I) Tamilnadu State Centre welcomed the gathering. **Er K N Sivaraju**, Honorary Secretary introduced the guest speaker **Er Sarathi Sarbadhikary**, CTO Rapid Serviz Engineering Ltd., Chennai.

Er Sarathi Sarbadhikary started his lecture with the introduction of the energy transition is set to transform the economic fundamentals of energy production over the next 30 years.


He explained about the Sustainability. Sustainability is about knowing—

- Where the organization measures on the sustainability scale (carbon footprint)
- Knowing the options available to improve upon sustainability
- Exploring the business trade-offs and financial paybacks

- Implementing strategies that improve the safety and profitability
- What are the key performance indicators (KPI's) to focus on sustainability?
- Safe operations as measured by zero incidents and zero discharges
- Operational metrics like energy usage, flare reduction, fugitive emission measurements and reduction
- Accounting of carbon intensity, water use, waste generation and community impacts

Digitalization is the use of digital technologies to change a business model and provide new revenue and value-producing opportunities; it is the process of moving to a digital business.

For example, converting handwritten or typewritten text into digital form is an example of digitization, as is converting the music from an LP or video off of a VHS tape. It's important to remember, however, that it's the information being digitized, not the processes that's where digitalization comes in.



An organization called Evonik established a digitalization subsidiary and named a chief digital officer (CDO) in 2017. The company has since moved to invest €100 MM (\$113 MM) in the development and testing of new digitization technologies. Dow added the title of CDO to its chief information officer to reinforce its emphasis on digital tools. In this role, the CDO leads a team of executives, business-line presidents and functional vice presidents to develop Dow's digital strategy.

Targeting a focused project is a good way to begin digitalization -

Design – develop the digital representation of an existing process

Operate – implement process control technology to improve production operations

Maintain – use data analytics to understand process failures and plan for abnormal process conditions.

This is the optimum time to research and investigate the

economics of the transition on the road to 2050:

Prepare a levelized cost comparison of each type of energy production

How relative costs are likely to develop, including trends in financing costs

Understand the role of gas (hydrogen) and LNG as a transition fuel


Understand the impact of the pandemic on the speed of the transition

Government policies that could drive mass rollout of low-carbon production

Potential pathways to meet the Paris Agreement / COP26 goal of net-zero emissions by 2050


Comparison of the approaches of the EU, US and Asia-Pacific economies and the impact on the trade in energy, including LNG

14, 12, 2021




