

Smart IOT devices for aged Persons

1. Visual

The aged people lack perfect vision and hence their movements are restricted. The smart spectacles having Bluetooth technology connects to the nearest android device or connect through wireless internet. It is having inbuilt camera which magnifies the object on the way for the easy movement of the aged people. Further, with

location device their movement can be easily monitored by the healthcare team.

2. Smart health care devices

The Fitbit device, heart monitoring gadgets, diet monitoring and glucose monitoring devices are embedded with sensors with necessary software with proper interfaces like WIFI connects the information data to the centralised server in order to have periodical monitoring of the Bio clinical parameters of aged persons.

3. Government of India Initiatives

The Ministry of Health and Family welfare has launched lot of digital enabled health monitoring applications for aged people across the country. The e-Sanjeevan telemedicine platform based on the ICT Technology enables the aged persons to access the doctor sitting at home at his convenient time through online and after the consultation, the prescription can be downloaded. This was much useful for the senior citizens during the Covid situation.

The m-diabetes, a mobile application with missed call to 011-22901701 provides the immediate consultations to the aged persons.

The e-hospital based on the ICT application has hospital management system where the aged person's health details and treatment details are captured remotely for the periodic health assessment.

Conclusion

The digital technology for health monitoring is available in the e-health and m-health applications to the aged persons. The inventions are underway to provide health, diet and stimulation to indoor activities in a single gadget including PC, TV, Tablet and sensor devices in order to provide healthy ageing. These technologies also should reach the aged persons living in rural and hilly areas.
