ROYAL CHARTER DAY 9th September 2025

The Tamilnadu State Centre of the Institution of Engineers (India) organised the Royal Charter Day on 9th September 2025 at 7.00 pm through online Zoom Meeting. At the outset, **Dr V Karthikeyan**, Chairman, IE(I) Tamilnadu State Centre delivered the welcome address.

Dr E Bhaskaran, Joint Director (Engineering) / General Manager, Department of Industries and Commerce, MSME Department, Government of Tamil Nadu was the chief guest.



Dr E Bhaskaran delivered the lecture on the topic "10 STEPS TO BECOME A STARTUP" with power point presentation. The Government of India and

concerned State Governments are implementing plenty of Programmes / Schemes for Startups and MSMEs in Tamil Nadu. Step 1 is funding under Innovation Voucher Programme A for Research upto Rs. 3 lakhs and B for Testing and Marketing around Rs. 7 lakhs through EDII. Rs.10 lakhs is given to General Startups and Rs, 15 lakhs to Rural, Women and Green Technology Startups through STARTUP TN / TANSIM.

Under Naan Mudalvan various skills training programme is given so as to become Self Employment or to get employment. In Step 2, Business Model Canvas and Business Plan preparation training is given. In step 3, they can start proprietor / partnership / private limited / public limited or Cooperative Societies.

In step 4, the purchase land through SIDCO / SIPCOT or get rented under TIDEL Park/ TICEL Park/ Biotechnology Park through TIDCO.

In Step 5, an entrepreneur has to purchase raw materials and machinery and the list of machinery is given in GeM portal. In Step 6, 154 clearances are given under Single Window Portal to get clearance from various departments like DTCP, Pollution Control Board, Fire Services, Health Department, DISH, Inspector of Boilers, TNEB, TWAD Board etc. to MSMEs through MSME Act and Business Facilitation Act. Under Step 7, Term Loan and Working Capital loan may be received from DIC and Banks under UYEGP, PMEGP, NEEDS, AABCS, PMFME, KKT etc with 25% capital investment subsidy and interest subsidy ranges from 3% to 6%. For Expansion / Diversification capital subsidy is given for existing entrepreneurs. EPF subsidy, Q-Certification subsidy, Energy Audit Subsidy is also given.

In step 8, EDP training is given from 3 days to 15 days under various DIC Schemes. In step 9, assistance is given for getting GST, PAN, ESI, EPF, EPS etc.

In step 10, MSMEs has to get Udyam Registration Certificate from Ministry of MSME. Finally for Marketing Government is helping through GeM, MSME Mart, for Employment through Naukari and Sampark websites and finally for export Entrepreneurs has to contact APEDA, MPEDA, AEPC, EEPC, CLE and various Export Promotion Councils.

To conclude Startups / MSMEs / Entrepreneurs / Students can make use of Government programmes on startups / entrepreneurship to decrease the cost of investment/ manufacturing and increase profit.
